Each year the school receives additional money called a 'pupil premium' which is allocated to us on the basis of the number of children who are entitled to 'free school meals' (FSM) or may be disadvantaged in other ways such as Forces children and Looked After Children (LAC). The money enables us to continue our work supporting these children and their families in order that they make the best possible progress in school.
