



Week 5 Daily Tasks

Below are some suggested activities to run alongside the Picture News Communicate: Animals plan. These are just suggestions and can be adapted to the needs of the children taking part.

Welcome

Start the session by greeting everyone individually by name such as “Good morning Jacob” and give them the opportunity to say good morning back. When welcoming everyone individually by name, encourage children to make eye contact.

Introduction Song

Teach the children ‘Down in the Jungle’ (see separate lyrics sheet). Invite each child to think of an animal they want to sing about and continue singing until everyone has had a turn.

Complete Daily Discussion

Day 1: You will need the **Picture News Animals poster, Resource 1** and see **Day 1** on the **Animals plan**.

Day 2: You will need the **Picture News Animals poster, Resource 1** and see **Day 2** on the **Animals plan**.

Day 3: You will need **Resource 1** to recap discussion from yesterday, **Resource 2** and see **Day 3** on the **Animals plan**.

Day 4: You will need **Resource 2** to recap discussion from yesterday, **Resource 3** and see **Day 4** on the **Animals plan**.

Day 5: You will need **Resource 3** to recap discussion from yesterday, **Resource 4** and see **Day 5** on the **Animals plan**.

Independent Drawing

Invite the children to draw a picture to show something they have been discussing in the session. Ask each child in turn to talk through their picture with you.
